BE SAFE AROUND NATURAL GAS

SUSPECT A LEAK? TAKE ACTION!

- 1 **LEAVE.**
If you ever suspect a natural gas leak, LEAVE IMMEDIATELY. Don't try to find or stop the leak.
- 2 **DO NOT TOUCH ANYTHING ELECTRICAL.**
Leave the building immediately. Do not use a phone. Do not smoke. Do not turn appliances or lights on or off. Do not operate any vehicle or equipment that could create a spark.
- 3 **CALL 911.**
Once you are out of the suspected area, immediately call 911.

CALL BEFORE YOU DIG: IT'S THE LAW.



Building a deck? Planting a tree? Installing a mailbox? Don't break the law – call 811 before you begin any digging project.

Excavation work, including simple yard digging, is the most common cause of natural gas emergencies. Before excavation of any kind – even small projects like planting shrubs – state law requires that you call 811 so all utility lines can be professionally marked before you begin. If you hit an underground utility line while digging, you can harm yourself or those around you, disrupt service to an entire neighborhood, and potentially be responsible for fines and repair costs.

NEW NATURAL GAS LINE COMPLETED

Beaches Energy Services completed installation of a new 4" natural gas main in fall 2017. This investment in our beach community allowed us to complete the southern loop of our natural gas system that provides redundancy and will allow us to maintain service to the vast majority of our natural gas customers south of Corona Road should emergency repairs or maintenance be required on any part of the natural gas main.
