Watching the clouds at the Beach can be a great escape, but with insufficient attic insulation, what's escaping is expensive conditioned air. Insulation's "R-value" is its resistance to heat flow. The rebate upgrades insulation to a minimum of R-19 (attic) or R-11 (floor). Tidings Tips: This Thanksgiving, Don't Gobble Energy

- **Oven Do's and Don't's:** Do cook several foods at once, with room for air circulation. Do use glass or ceramic pans, and turn the temperature down 25°. Turn off the oven several minutes before the food is fully cooked. Don't preheat the oven except for bread. And don't open the door to peek! (Use the oven light and window.)
- **Stovetop Do's and Don't's:** Do cover pots to cook faster, turn off the heat to finish cooking, and use clean, high-quality burner reflectors. Don't put a small pan on a large burner. You'll waste some 40% of the energy!

Extra-Smart Cooking Do's: Do use your super-energy-efficient microwave, toaster oven, crock-pot, and electric skillet.

Dishwashing Do's and Don't's:

Do run full dishwasher loads, and use cold water to prerinse dishes, if necessary. Don't use a dishwasher's heatdry feature. It can consume more energy than the wash



cycle. When you wash by hand, don't run the hot water continuously.
