## **Tidings** Tips: Weathering Power Outages

When the power goes out due to severe weather or other unforeseeable situations, Beaches Energy makes every attempt to restore it as quickly as possible. Here are some ways to save perishables and light the darkness until the power is restored:

- If your power is out for less than 4 hours, the food in your refrigerator and freezer are still safe to consume.
- · A freezer that is half full or more will hold food safely for up to 24 hours. A full freezer will hold food safely for 48 hours. Do not open the freezer door if you can avoid it.
- Pack milk, other dairy products, meat, fish, eggs gravy and spoilable leftovers into a cooler surrounded by ice. Inexpensive coolers are fine for this purpose.
- Use a food thermometer to check the temperature of food before you cook or eat it. Discard any food that has temperature above 40 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Always cook food outside on any sort of grill to avoid carbon monoxide poisoning or chemical fumes.
- Battery operated flameless candles are inexpensive and safe.
- Cell phones emit a glow to safely light your way to find other light sources that last for a longer time or emit more light.
- · LED flashlights emit a strong beam of light that lasts for a long time, and they come in a range of types and sizes.
- Crankshaft-powered lanterns or flashlights never need batteries.
