



# HURRICANE SEASON'S HERE: TIME TO PREPARE

With the arrival of hurricane season, it's a good time to make preparations for the possible arrival. A watch is when a hurricane may threaten coastal and inland areas within the next 48 hours. A warning is when a hurricane is expected to strike within 36 hours.

### IN CASE OF A WATCH OR WARNING

Our website has detailed actual preparations to make in the case of either a watch or a warning, and a downloadable disaster kit at www.beachesenergy.com.

In the event of a hurricane emergency, Beaches Energy Services' customers will be notified in advance of any plans for evacuation through the media. CodeRED Emergency Notification system will provide special notification alerts and announcements such as debris collection, road closures, power outages, etc. Visit beachesenergy.com to register for CodeRED Notifications.

## SCAM ALERT

Utility customers nationwide have reported receiving unsolicited phone calls regarding past due bills and disconnection of service.

Typically, the caller offers free services or demands immediate payment through a prepaid debit card. Some scammers may even appear at your door. Follow these tips to stay protected:

- Do not make any payment to anonymous callers.
- Do not allow anyone into your home if you have not initiated the appointment.
- Try to get the solicitor's name, phone number and any other related information.
