## CALL 811 BEFORE YOU DIG: IT'S THE LAW

Building a deck or planting a tree? Dial 811 at least a few days before you start any digging project.

A Beaches Energy representative will conduct a quick inspection of the digging site to mark the location of buried lines. Power lines, natural gas and other utilities are buried underground, even in places you might not expect.

Make the **free** call to 811 to help prevent unintended consequences such as injury to you or your family, damage to your property, utility service outages to the entire neighborhood and potential fines and repair costs.
