Sea Turtle Nesting Safety



SEATURTLE SAFETY IS IN OUR HANDS

It's sea turtle nesting season, and you know what that means – Beaches Energy and the Beaches Sea Turtle Patrol are jumping into action to help protect hatchlings. But there are a few things you can do to help:

Prepare Your Home

If you live on the beachfront, shield direct light coming from your home and choose low-watt bulbs to avoid confusing hatchlings.

Stick to Beach Days

Avoid unneeded light, noise or movement on the beach at night, when nests and hatchlings are harder to spot.

Leave No Trace

Keep nesting areas clear by cleaning up trash and other items, filling holes and flattening sandcastles before you leave.

Do Not Disturb

Don't walk or cycle on beach dunes and do not disturb sea turtle tracks, eggs, adults, or hatchlings.
